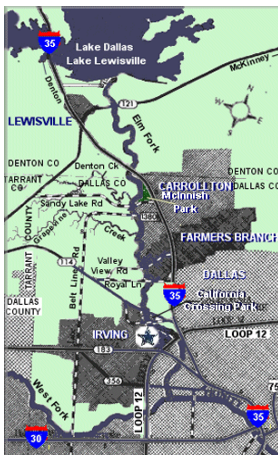


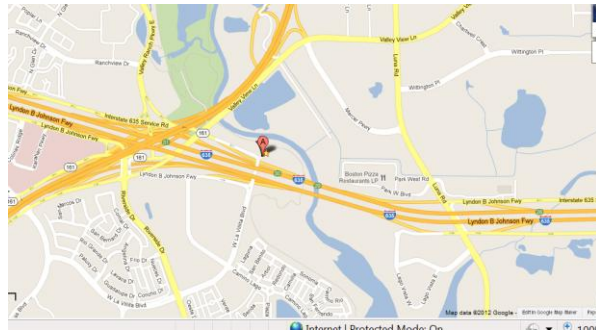


Please join Keep Irving Beautiful for the 2012 "Don't Mess with Texas Trash-Off/Great American Cleanup."

The "Don't Mess with Texas Trash-Off" is Texas' signature event for the Great American Cleanup, the nation's largest community improvement program, sponsored by Keep America Beautiful. Keep Irving Beautiful's March 31, 2012 event will be a waterway cleanup, with 30 kayak spots available on a first come, first served basis. We will be cleaning a section of the Elm Fork of the Trinity River as we paddle from Carrollton Canoe Launch to TW Richardson Grove Park. The Trinity River system drains an area of 11.5 million acres and supports the water needs of 40% of the Texas population, nearly 9 million people, so please join us to help keep its #1 pollutant - litter - out of the waterway.
