

# Irving Police Department Racial Profiling Report for 2006

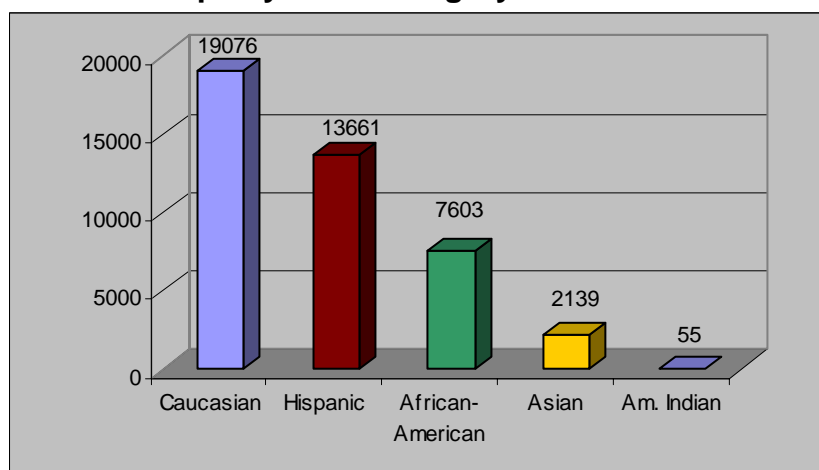

Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 2.132, requires every police agency making traffic stops leading to a citation or arrest to report information on the race of individuals detained and whether they were searched. The information below was compiled by the Irving Police Department to meet this requirement for stops between January 1 and December 31, 2006.
